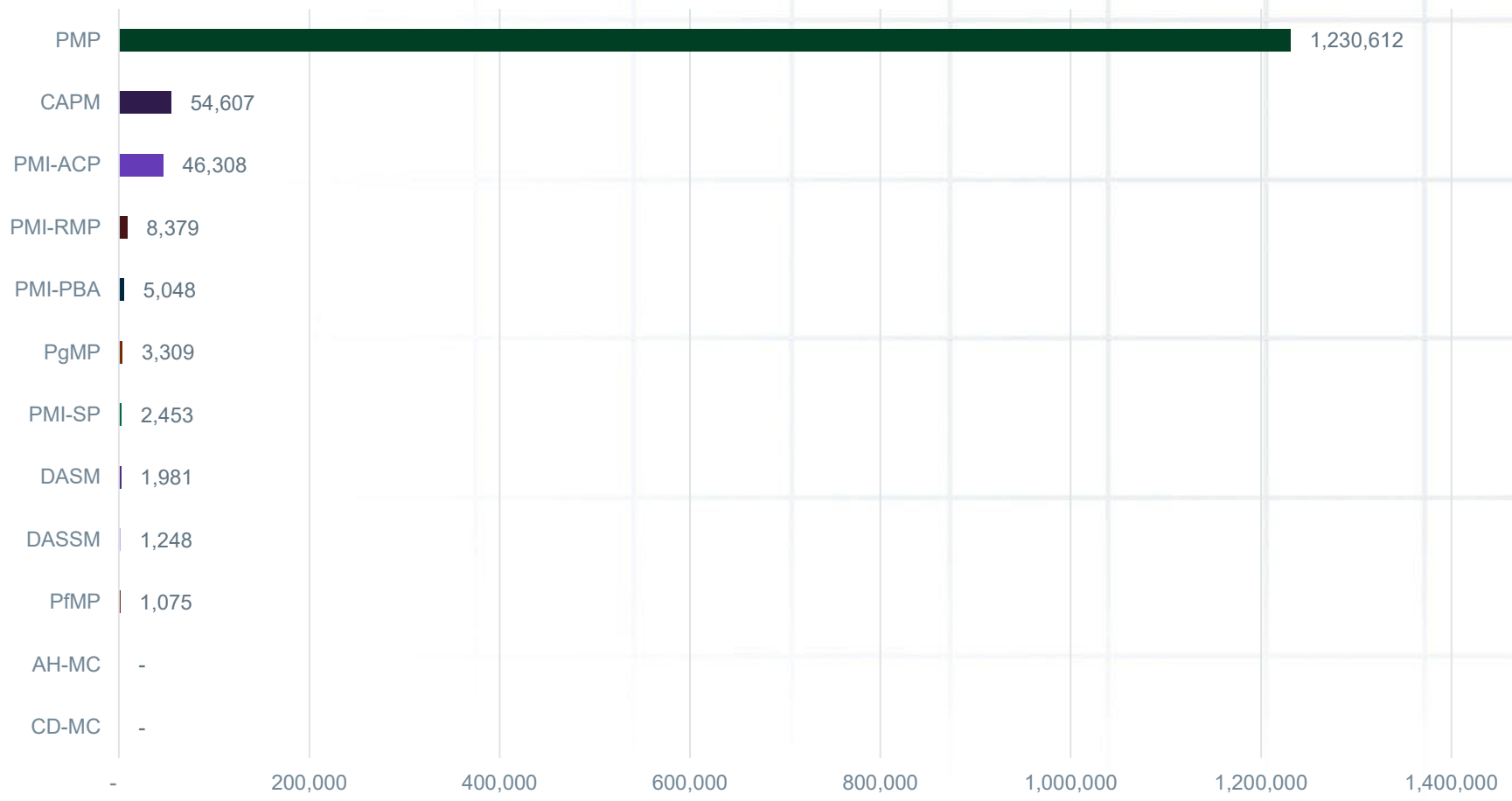

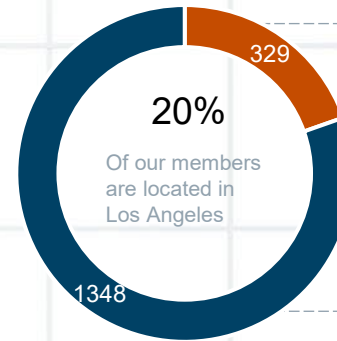

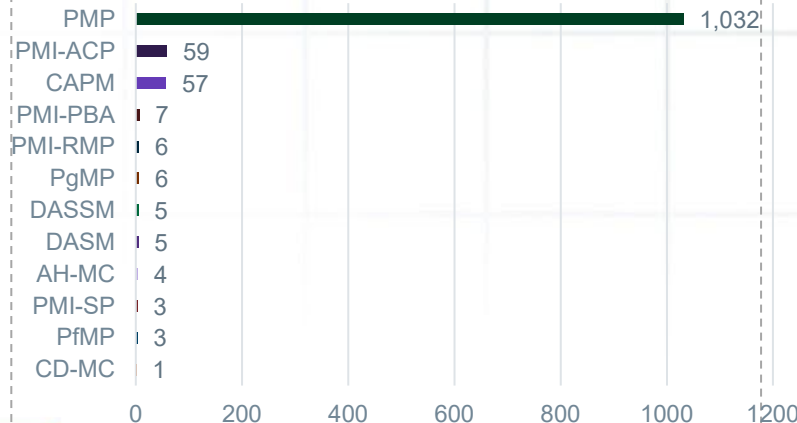

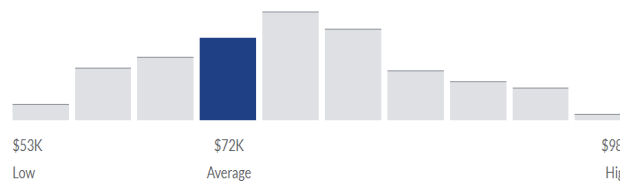

A valuable entry-level certification for project practitioners and designed for those with little or no project experience, the CAPM® can get your career on the right path or take it to the next level.

Requires 23 hours of PM education (one semester class is enough) and passing the 150-question exam.

Certification is valid for five years.

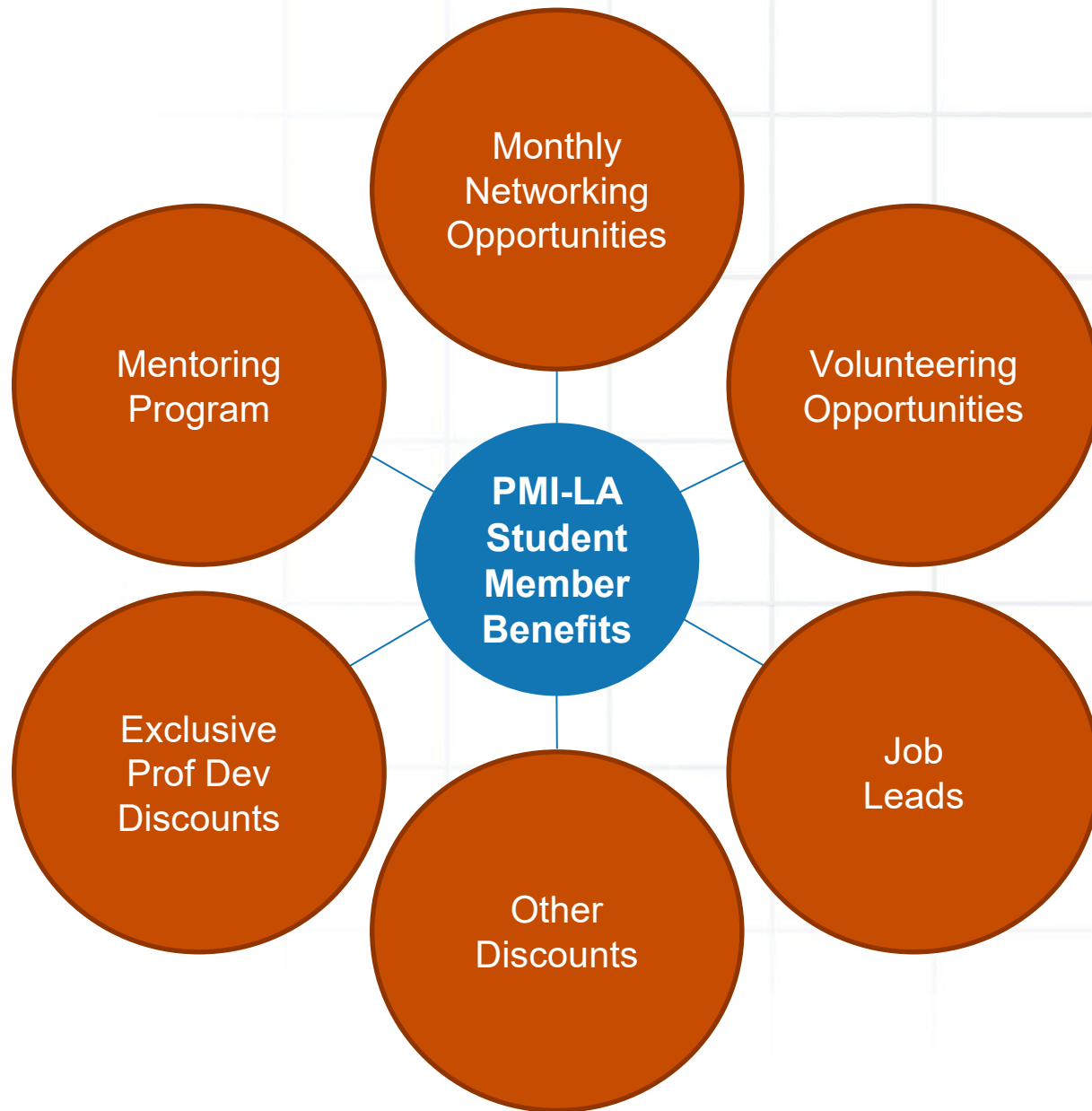
