








Credential Growth in April 2024



Credentials Expiring in April 2024






High Demand Jobs

Project Manager Salary in Los Angeles, CA Comparison by Location



 Requires 23 hours of PM education (one semester class is enough) and passing the 150-question exam.

Certification is valid for five years.




