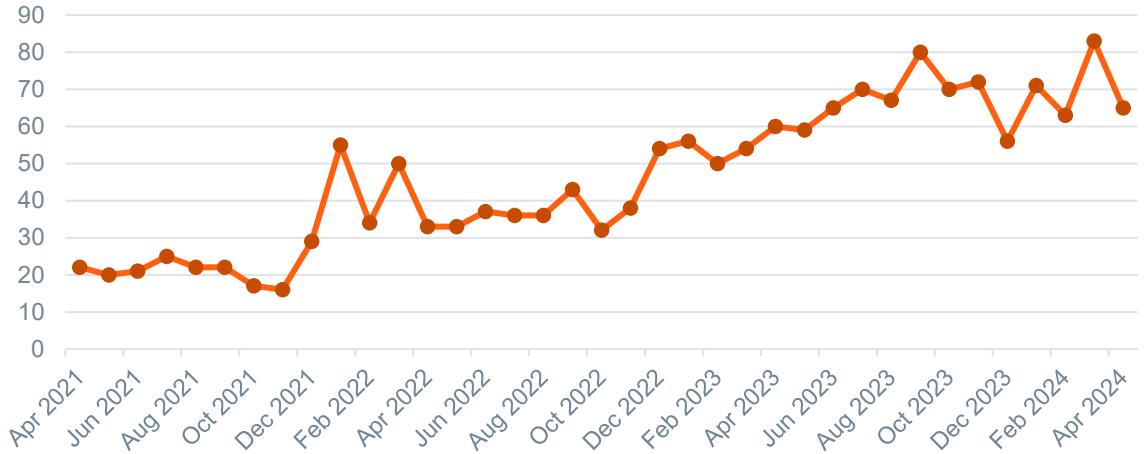

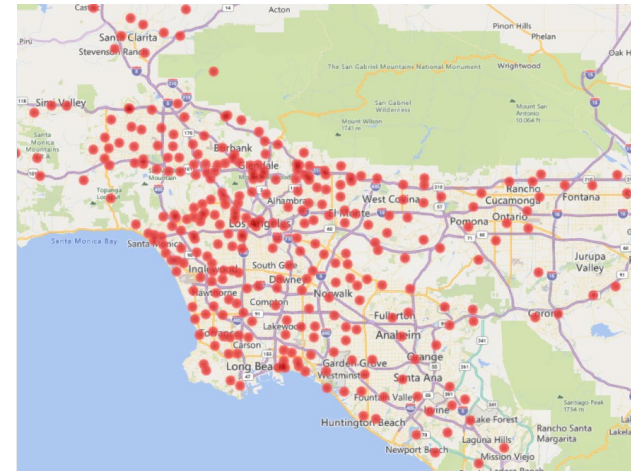
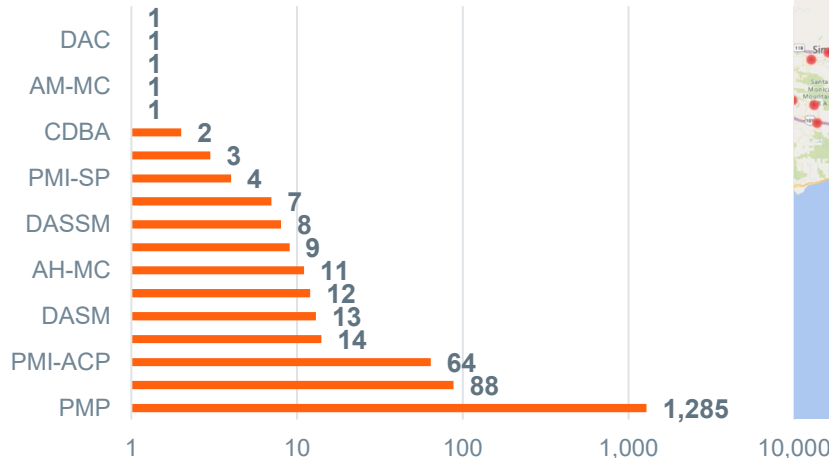

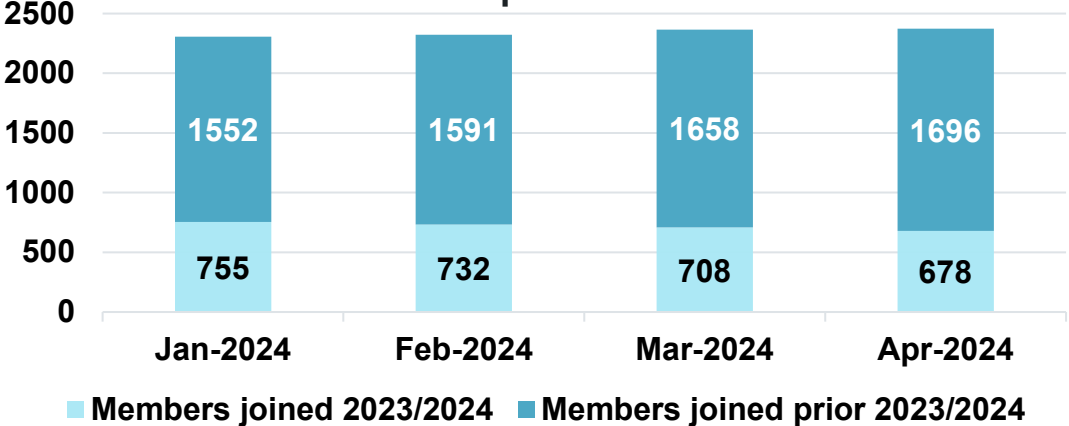
Credentials Breakdown



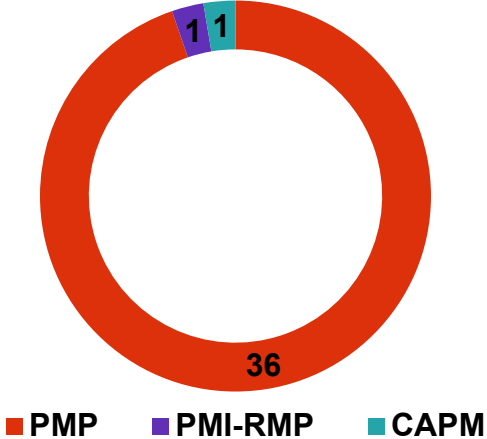

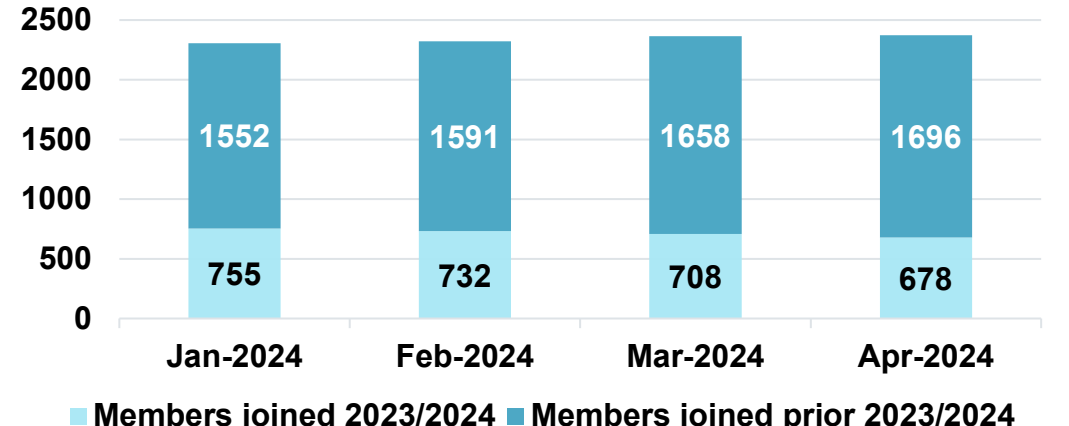
Membership Count in 2024



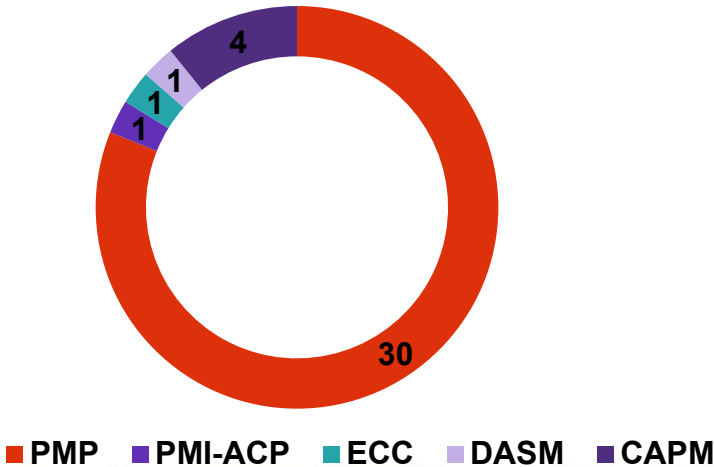
Credential Growth in April 2024



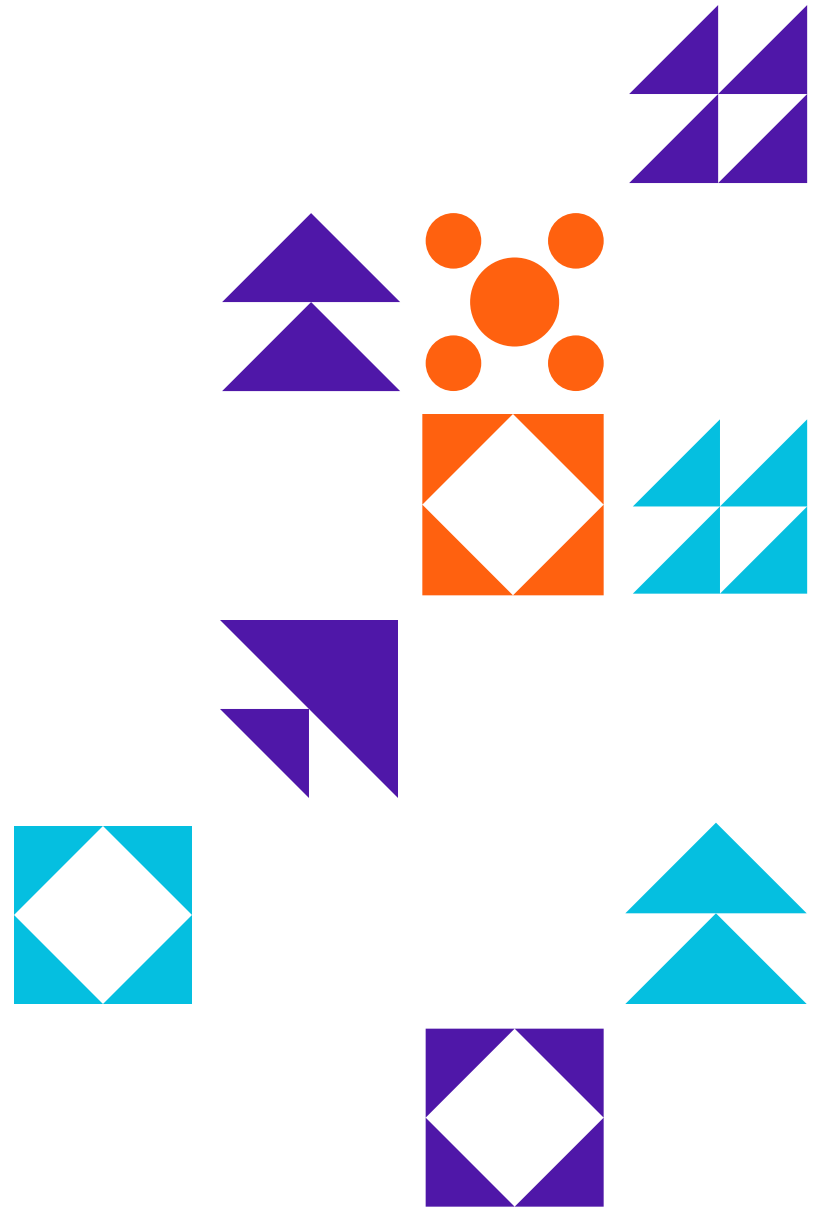
Membership Growth in 2024

2.3 million people will be needed each year to fill all of the project management-oriented positions expected to open by 2030.

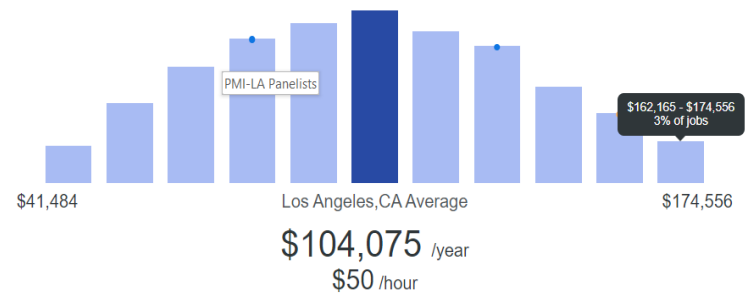

Project Manager Salary in Los Angeles, CA

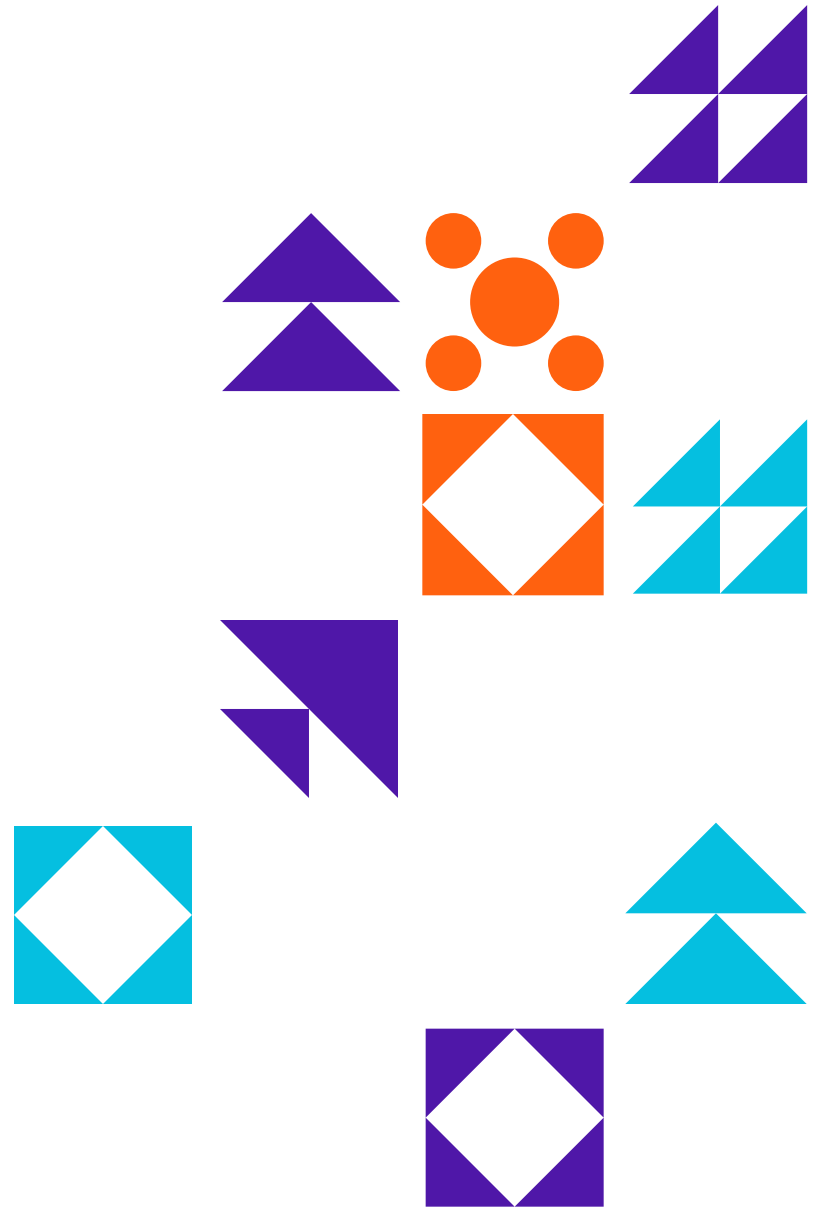
Yearly Monthly Weekly Hourly Table View

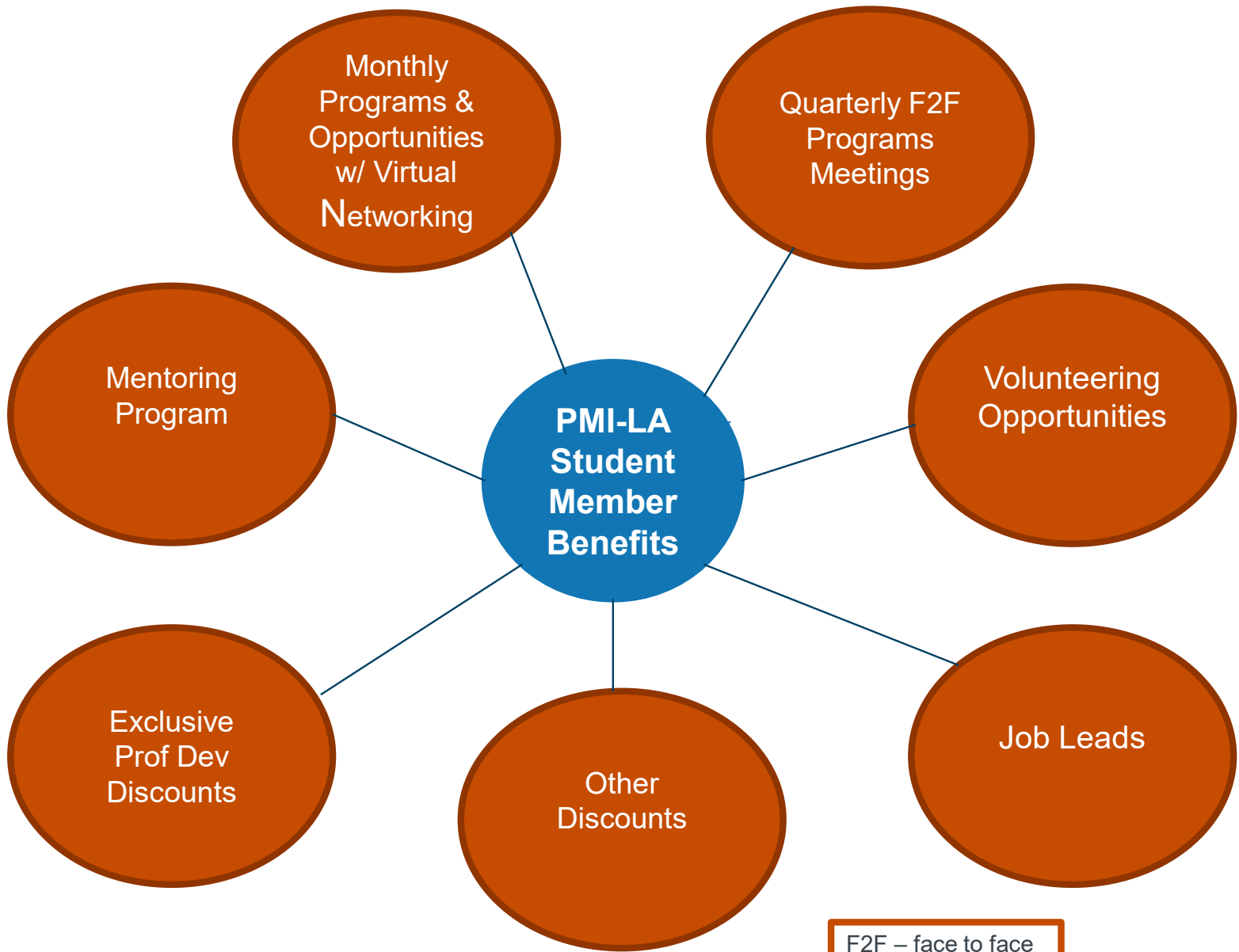
